If You Play in Our Tournaments, Read This:

If you play (or plan to play) in any Men's Club tournaments, you need to be aware of the new Pace of Play Rules that went into effect on July 1, 2024.

For the first time, the Board of the Men's Club is establishing rules that provide for **penalty strokes to be given during any tournament round.**

The penalty strokes will apply to **every member** of a foursome, even if **just one individual member of the group is the cause of the group being Out of Position.**

The details of the new rules can be found on the following page.

Aug. 18 (Sun.) Brae in a Day. Two-man teams playing six holes each of Scramble, Better Ball and Aggregate. 8am shotgun on the Babe.

Sept. 7 (Sat.) The Board Surprise. 18 holes of Medal Play with some surprises. 8am shotgun on the Ike.

Oct. 12 (Sat.) the Youpa Challenge. Two-man teams, playing the Modified Chapman format. 8am shotgun on the Ike.

Nov. 16 (Sat.) The Fall Classic and Annual Meeting. Modified Stableford. 8am shotgun on the Babe.

Dec. 3 (Tue.) The Performers' Classic. Blind draw of partners, Better Ball. (You must qualify through Performers Points.)

Dec. 8 (Sun.) The Christmas Classic. Two-man teams, Four-ball Match Play. 8am on the Ike.

Industry Hills Men's Club Pace of Play Rules for Tournaments

In response to many complaints related to pace of play, the Board has adopted a new policy.

As most of you know, we have already had Pace of Play Rules that are as follows:

1. No penalties will be assessed if your scorecard is turned in within 5-1/2 hours of the start of the tournament.
2. Any player turning in his scorecard after the 5-1/2 hour deadline and 20 minutes after the last player in the foursome ahead of him will cause the player to incur a 2-stroke penalty. He would still be eligible for Buy-in payouts, using his 2-stroke penalty.
3. Any player turning in his scorecard after the 5-1/2 hour deadline and 30 or more minutes after the last player in the foursome ahead of him will cause the player to be DQ'd.

The 5-1/2 hour limit is arbitrary, but should be easily met, provided everyone tries to stay up with the group ahead of them. Scorecards will show the time allotted to play each hole in order to complete the round in 5 hours as a guideline. If your group has exceeded the allotted time on a hole, the entire group should try to make that time up.

Moving forward, each of our events will feature **Tournament Marshalls (TMs)**, a team of two men consisting of current IH Board Members and/or IH Advisors (former Presidents of the Board). The TMs will not play in the event, but will be responsible for advising groups if they are out of position.

The definition of "Out off Position" is as follows:

1. If a group comes to the tee of a par 3 and the group ahead of them **has cleared the next tee, or**
2. If a group comes to the tee of a par 4 and the group ahead of them **has cleared the green, or**
3. If a group comes to the tee of a par 5 and the group ahead of them **is on the green,**

The group will be deemed to be Out of Position.

If a group is deemed to be Out of Position, they will be given a warning and requested to get back into position within the next two holes. At that time, each player will be expected to be prepared to play his next shot as soon as the previous player has hit his. We expect the warning to be sufficient for all of the players in the group to get back into position.

If after 2 holes the group is still out of position, a 1-stroke penalty will be assessed to each member of the group and will be assigned to the hole where the penalty is assessed.

If after the first penalty, the group is again found to be Out of Position, they will have two additional holes to get back into position again. If they are found to be Out of Position after those two holes, a 2-stroke penalty will be assessed to each member of the group, and will be assigned to the hole where the penalty is assessed.
