Results of the Board Surprise

Sixty hardy players teed it up for this year's Board Surprise in 100-degree heat. Congratulations to all who finished the round!

The format was Individual Medal Play, but with some twists. For starters, only five of the eighteen holes were played from the (normal) White tees for this event. All of the other holes were played from Red or Blue tees, except for the one which was played from the Blacks. (Isn't 17 a great hole from the Black tee?) When you add it all up (see table on page 3) this setup at 6,170 yards is only 3% shorter than the course from the regular White tees.

In addition, the players had to make a choice on two par threes (5 and 13) where they could put toward a regular cup or a cup that was 14 inches in diameter, but in a trickier location. All in all, it makes for an interesting round. Well done with the setup, Board Members!

Congratulations go to Gerry Delgado, who won the Low Gross title with a 67, edging out Mark Miller by a single stroke.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS CANDIDATE QUALIFICATION STATEMENT

I, _____, submit my name in nomination as a candidate for election to the Industry Hills Men's Golf Association Board of Directors. I am a member of the IHMGA in good standing, and will endeavor to remain so at all relevant times.

I understand and acknowledge that, if elected, my duties and responsibilities as a member of the IHMGA Board of Directors shall include:

- A. Doing "whatever is necessary" to carry out the IHMGA Board's primary function as the Tournament, Handicap and Rules Committees for all IHMGA golf tournaments and related events. I acknowledge that these responsibilities include (a) being computer literate (b) having access to a laptop computer that can be used for scoring IHMGA events when and as needed, and (c) being intimately familiar with (and staying up to date on) all aspects of the USGA Rules of Golf, the USGA Handicap Manual, the SCGA's GHIN Handicapping system, and the current scoring software being used by the Board for IHMGA events. This will require that I attend and participate in both on and off-site training seminars on an ongoing basis as deemed necessary by the Board and/or the IHMGA President.
- B. Working at, attending and participating in (virtually) all IHMGA events, including all weekend tournaments, weekday Guest Days and Team Play. I understand that this may require that I show up early and/or stay late "doing the necessary" at each such IHMGA event.
- C. Attending monthly IHMGA Board meetings.
- D. Acting as a liaison between our IHMGA members and Pacific Palms management, keeping our Member golfer's best interests at heart.
- E. Acting as an "Ambassador of the Hill", promoting our club and our facilities whenever and wherever appropriate.
- F. Performing all other duties assigned by the Board, Pacific Palms management, and/or the IHMGA President as needed or as is appropriate.

I certify that I am prepared to carry out each of these functions, and ask that my name be placed on the ballot for the upcoming IHMGA Board of Directors election.

2025 Men's Club Calendar of Events

The Men's Club Board has added an additional tournament to the 2025 schedule. The Waddell Open format will be two-man teams, Better Ball Net Play **as a qualifying tournament**. The top 16 teams in each flight will be entered in brackets for Team Match Play.
