## Results of the Youpa Challenge

Sixty-two players teed it up for the Youpa Challenge this year. The format was two-man teams, Modified Chapman format on the Eisenhower course. The goal is always to beat the score posted by the team of Director of Golf Dave Youpa and this year's Men's Club President, Vince Barraza.

The Chapman format requires some strategy and a lot of forgiveness of your partner. Here's how it works: each player hits a tee shot on every hole. When they reach their drives, each player switches and hits his partner's ball for the second shot. When they reach their second shots, the team has to decide which one of the two balls they will play for the rest of the hole, and they play Alternate Shot until the ball is holed. On the next tee, they start all over.

The contest is for the Low Net score, and the Challenge Pool is divided by the number of teams who beat (not tie) the score posted by Youpa/Barraza. This year, that score was 67, five under par, and only one team beat it. Congratulations to the team of David Sockett and Fernando Fernandez, who beat Youpa/Barraza by a single stroke. The Low Net scores are shown below, and the Skins winners are on the following page.

## 2025 Men's Club Calendar of Events
