## New for 2025 Team play Season

### Playing Handicap Calculation:

To be more accurate/precise and decrease the number of rounding occurrences, the Rules of Handicapping update includes a clarification to the procedure for the calculation of the Course and Playing Handicap for concurrent Four-Ball and Individual matches. We want to make you aware of this change, as it is being applied for SCGA Team Play.

In the 2024 season, the handicaps for Four-Ball Match Play were calculated using unrounded course handicap values, while individual matches were calculated using rounded course handicap values.

Starting in 2025, **BOTH** Four-Ball and Individual Match Play playing handicaps will be calculated using the difference in unrounded course handicaps.

As an example:

Player A's Unrounded Course Handicap is +.880

Player B's Unrounded Course Handicap is 7.705

Player C's Unrounded Course Handicap is 3.133

Player D's Unrounded Course Handicap is 4.471

Playing Handicaps take *the difference* of the **unrounded Course Handicap value** from the lowest player in the group in comparison to other players in the group and then rounding that difference to determine the Playing Handicap. Using the example the initial unrounded Course Handicap calculations are as follows:

Player	Difference from Player A	Playing Handicap
A	0	0
B	8.585	9
C	4.013	4
D	5.351	5

For the Individual Matches, the playing handicap is based off the low player in the match. In this case, the difference between Player B and Player D is 3.234 (7.705 – 4.471), which means that Player D is getting 3 strokes off Player B in their individual match.

The calculation of this value using this procedure is automatically done in Golf Genius. The Handicap Analysis section, which captains have access to via the Team Captain Menu, will break this procedure calculation down in steps. This feature may result in players having a similar Playing Handicap but receiving a different number of strokes.

# SCGA Multi-Member Rebate Program

Good news! The SCGA offers a rebate program for golfers who are members of more than one SCGA club.

For each membership year, anyone who is a member of the SCGA through more than one club is eligible to apply for and receive a rebate directly from the SCGA for any dues they pay the SCGA that exceed \$55.

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

Members must be a multi-member for at least 60 days at 2 or more clubs in a 12-month cycle in order to be eligible for the rebate and must be active at all clubs when submitting the application. Please allow up to 4 weeks for processing once you've met your eligibility requirements. Rebates are based on an annual membership cycle and members must reapply for the rebate each year.

## **CHOOSE HOW YOU RECEIVE YOUR REBATE:**

You can now choose how to receive your rebate! Once your eligibility requirements have been met, you will receive an email from [membership@scga.org](mailto:membership@scga.org) and can choose to receive your rebate via mobile deposit, ACH deposit, printable check, or request to have a paper check sent to your home.

The SCGA charges \$36 per member per club. Therefore, the rebate breakdown is as follows:

- Member at 2 clubs = \$17
- Member at 3 clubs = \$53
- Member at 4 clubs = \$89
- Member at 5 clubs = \$125
- Member at 6 or more clubs = \$161

**Applications received after Dec. 31, 2024, will be considered 2025 rebate applications.**

## **TERMS AND EXCLUSIONS:**

All submissions are subject to verification by the SCGA. Confirmation by SCGA that clubs each paid \$36 on behalf of the member is required. Memberships that are excluded from the SCGA multi-member rebate program, include, but are not limited to JUNIOR memberships (individuals under the age of 19 when SCGA billing to the club took place) and Memberships with ASSOCIATIONS other than the SCGA (NCGA (Northern CA), CDGA (Chicago), etc.)
