IHMGA RULES INFORMATION

Adjustment of Hole Scores

Q. I started a hole but did not complete it. What score do I post?

A. When the format of play allows you to start a hole but not complete it, the score recorded for handicap purposes is your most likely score, equal to:

- The number of strokes already taken on the hole, plus
- Any penalty strokes incurred during the hole, plus
- The number of strokes you would most likely require to complete the hole.

A most likely score is a reasonable assessment made by you based on the score you are most likely to make from that spot more than half the time. The following guidelines should be used to determine a most likely score:

- If the ball lies on the putting green no more than 5 feet from the hole, add one stroke.
- If the ball lies between 5 feet and 20 yards from the hole, add 2 or 3 additional strokes depending on the position of the ball, difficulty of the green and your ability.
- If the ball lies more than 20 yards from the hole, add 3 or 4 additional strokes depending on the position of the ball, difficulty of the green and your ability. (Rule 3.3, Rules of Handicapping)

The USGA Handicap Review Tool is continuing to roll out in a phased approach, and we are pleased to announce that Phase Two launched TODAY. Phase Two includes the ability for a Handicap Committee to run a handicap review across its club's roster. Some things to keep in mind as you implement the handicap review:

- When a club-wide review is run, only home club golfers will be eligible for a recommended
 adjustment. Non-home club golfers will remain eligible for an individual review. For golfers whose
 Handicap Index is active at more than one club, the home club is the primary golf club designated
 by the golfer.
- A golfer must have a full scoring record (20 scores) to be eligible for a recommended adjustment.
- The committee will receive an upgraded Details Modal for any golfer recommended for an adjustment.
- The Handicap Committee will have 14 days from the time of the review to apply or deny a recommended adjustment, after which the recommendation will expire.

Don't forget the Handicap Chair/Committee must notify your players of the club's handicap review process, including when the Handicap Index adjustment becomes effective as well as the timeframe for any appeals. More information about notifications, appeals and the two paths can be found in the toolkit.
